

Extended information text concerning the use of cookies

This web site uses technical cookies to ensure the correct functioning of procedures and to improve the online application use experience. This document provides information on the use of cookies and similar technologies, on how they are used by the site and how to manage them.

Definitions

Cookies are small text files which are sent to the terminals of the websites visited by users, where they are stored, to then be retransmitted to the same sites on the next visit. Cookies of the so-called "third party" are, instead, set by a web site other than the one the user is visiting. This is because on each site elements (pictures, maps, sounds, specific links to web pages in other domains, etc.) may be present, which in turn reside on servers other than the site being visited.

Types of cookies

Depending on the characteristics and the use of cookies you can distinguish different categories:

• Technical Cookies.

Technical cookies are those only used in order to carry out the transmission of a communication over an electronic communication network, or to the extent strictly necessary to the supplier of an information society service, explicitly requested by the subscriber or user to deliver this service" (cf. art. 122, paragraph 1 of the Code). They are not used for other purposes and are normally directly installed by the owner or operator of the web site. They can be divided into browser cookies or sessions, which guarantee a normal browsing and use of the web site; cookie analytics, assimilated to technical cookies where used directly by the operator of the site to gather information in an aggregate form, on the number of users and how they may visit the website itself; cookie function, which allow user browsing as a function of a number of selected criteria in order to improve the service rendered to the same. For installation of these cookies the user's prior consent is not required, while it remains obligatory to give the informative as provided in art. 13 of the Code, which, provided the operator of the site only uses these devices, can be provided with the modalities they consider most appropriate.

Profiling cookies

Profiling cookies are aimed at creating profiles relative to the user and are used in order to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user whilst browsing the net. Because of the particular invasiveness that such devices may have in the private sphere of users, the European and Italian legislation foresees that the user should be adequately informed about the use of these cookies and express their valid consent. They refer to art. 122 of the Code which forecasts that "the storage of information in the terminal equipment of a contractor or a user or the access to information already stored are only allowed on condition that the contractor or the user has expressed their consent after being informed with the simplified modalities referred to in Article 13, sub-paragraph 3" (Art. 122, paragraph 1 of the Code). This site does not use cookies for profiling.

"Third party" Cookies

By visiting this website you may get cookies from sites managed by other organizations ("Third Party"). An example is represented by the presence of "social plug-in" for Facebook, Twitter, Google+ or LinkedIn, or systems for viewing multimedia content embedded (integrated) such as YouTube or Flikr. These are parts that are generated directly from these sites and integrated into the web page of the host site being visited. The presence of these plug-in involves the transmission of cookies from and towards all the sites managed by third parties. The management of the information gathered from "third party" is governed by the relevant informative which we ask you to refer to. Duration of cookies

Some cookies (session cookie) remain active only until the browser is closed or the execution of any command to logout. Other cookies "survive" at the closing of the browser and are also available in subsequent visits by the user. These cookies are called persistent and their duration is fixed from the server at the time of their creation. In some cases a duration deadline is created, in other cases the duration is unlimited.

Cookie Management

The user can decide whether or not to accept cookies using the settings of their browser. Attention: disabling total or partial technical cookies may compromise the optimal use of the site. Disabling "third party cookies" does not compromise browsing in any way. The settings can be defined in a specific ways for different web sites and web applications. Moreover browsers allow you to define different settings for cookie "owners" and for those of "Third Party". For example, in Firefox, via the menu Tools->Options->Privacy, you can access a control panel where you can define whether or not to accept different types of cookies and remove them.
